

A Patient-Centered Medical Home is a Partnership Between the Patient and Their Physician

Being a part of a Patient-Centered Medical Home, your doctor will:

- Work with you to improve your health
- Review your medications at every visit and discuss with you any interactions or contraindications
- Electronically prescribe your medications to ensure they are accurate and available to you promptly
- Develop a personal action plan with you to address your chronic conditions
- Set goals with you and monitor your progress
- Use computer technology to monitor your progress and determine if your health is improving
- Inform you of all test results
- Help you take control of your health by providing you educational material, hosting group visits and linking you to other community programs and resources
- Provide you 24 hour access to a clinical decision-maker by phone
- Have arrangements with after-hours care to be informed of your visit or emergent treatment within 24 hours or next business day
- Reserve space in our schedule for you to accommodate a same-day appointment

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By choosing to participate in a Patient-Centered Medical Home, I agree to:

- Make sure my doctor knows my entire medical history
- Tell my doctor all of the medications I am taking
- Actively participate with my doctor in planning my care
- Keep my appointments as scheduled
- Adhere to the action plan designed by my doctors
- Consult my doctor before making my own appointment with a Specialist
- Request that any other doctor I see send my doctor a report, copies of lab work, test results, and x-rays
- Know my insurance and what it covers
- Provide the office feedback on how they can improve

The Patient-Centered Medical Home Philosophy

What is Patient-Centered Medical Home?

Patient-Centered Medical Home or PCMH is a program, supported by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan, which provides a comprehensive approach to primary care for children, youth and adults. The PCMH is a health care setting that facilitates partnerships between individual patients, their personal physicians, and when appropriate, the patient's family.

Do I have to be covered by Blue Cross Blue Shield to participate?

No. All patients of this Primary Care Office are eligible for participation in PCMH regardless of health plan affiliation.

Are all Primary Care Physicians participating in this program?

No. Inclusion in the PCMH Designation Program is limited to a group of Primary Care Physicians, collaboratively selected by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan and United Physicians, P.C. for their recognized quality of care and early progress in implementing PCMH processes.

How will I benefit as a patient?

Patients who choose to receive care through the PCMH model will benefit by the following: access to doctors who utilize improved technologies to stay better connected with the medical community and manage care more efficiently; more focused, personal interaction with doctors and care teams who will help navigate through the complex healthcare system; a more comprehensive delivery of primary care through the improved coordination of care, managed by the patient's personal doctor and their care team.

What do I have to do as a patient?

As a patient you will need to commit to improving your healthcare and work with your physician to achieve healthcare goals.
