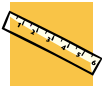

- Uses spoon
- Tries to run
- Increasing vocabulary
- Gives hugs and kisses

16-18 MONTHS:

- Mimics
- Tests limits/acts out frustrations
- Turns pages of books
- Loves to look at faces/babies
- Likes repetitive activities



CAR SEAT SAFETY: Forward facing car seat at 1 year AND 20 pounds.
Michigan law requires all children under age 8 and under 4'9" to be buckled in a child safety seat or booster seat.
